- Fill out all blanks on the application; if something does not apply to you, put N/A in that blank.
- When completing your Budget Worksheet (page 2) of the application, be as thorough and accurate as possible, but round to whole dollars. If you have no income or expense for an item listed, remember to put N/A in that blank. If you have no income, you will need to give a brief explanation of how you meet your monthly expenses. If you have no rent or house payment, you need to give a brief explanation of where you live.
- Remember to put a dollar amount in the "AMOUNT OF THIS REQUEST" box.

- **SUBMIT YOUR COMPLETED APPLICATION PACKET:** (Official transcripts (transcripts and reference letters must be in their own sealed envelope) 2 reference letters on letter head, if from a professional, (one must be from a teacher), and this completed application. Please do not staple any portion of the packet.
- It is recommended you send your packet with delivery confirmation.
- Applications must be received by June 7. No late, or incomplete applications will be considered.
- Once your application is received you will be given delivery receipt confirmation either by phone or email within 48 hours.
- Scholarship winners will be notified by June 30.
- If awarded, please know that this is a one-time only scholarship.
- Awards will be mailed directly to the institution you will be attending.
